Project launch in December 2023

The Erasmus+ project "Teaching case studies online: How to design and teach case studies in vocational schools" (short: TeC@ses) by the Universities of Antwerp, Cologne (coordinating body), Tampere and the University of Economics and Business in Prague aims to strengthen vocational educators for the digital age.

The project focuses on the development of an innovative e-learning tool, the TeC@ses tool, specially designed for case study design and teaching. This tool will work on two levels:

Firstly, teachers are introduced to the didactically high-quality development of case studies. Secondly, the TeC@ses tool promotes the development and teaching of digital skills of teachers in order to develop digitalised case studies and teach them in a digitalised context.

The TeC@ses tool integrates interactive learning support in the form of a learning path through its modules. Within the tool, practical examples and pedagogical steps for teaching are created and development elements as well as interactive exercises are built in. These resources are designed to equip teachers with the skills to create high-quality, practical case studies.

The TeC@ses tool, that will be available in Czech, Dutch, English, Finnish and German, is not only a means for

teachers to improve their skills using new media channels, but also serves as a platform for developing the digital skills needed for media-enhanced and innovative teaching. [Click here](#) to visit the the main page of TeC@ses.
